

ADVENTURER'S COVE / B.A.P. Climbing Tower 2010

Our individual climbing tower passes and group rates are as follows:
(not including Swing and Zip)

Individual 2 hour climbing pass-cost \$7
Harness rental \$3

Individual 3 hour climbing pass-cost \$10
Harness rental \$3

Individual day climbing pass-cost \$12
Harness rental \$3

Off-Season Schedule:

Reservations may be made for weekdays during the off season after 4:30pm.

Weekend reservations can be scheduled for Saturday between the hours of 9:30am and 6:30pm.

There will be no reservations made for Sundays.

Personal Belay services \$25 / 2 hour session

Belay instructional training \$20

2 ½ Hour Group Climbing Sessions / Birthday Parties, Youth Groups, etc.

Group of 10 -- cost \$110 (includes equipment rental and 2 belayers)

Additional climbers \$10 per person up to 14

Group of 15 -- cost \$160 (includes equipment rental and 3 belayers)

Additional climbers \$10 per person up to 19

Group of 20 -- cost \$185 (includes equipment rental and 4 belayers)

Full payment is required seven days prior to date of group services and fifteen days prior during off-season.

Bouldering and climbing with the use of ropes **MUST PASS BELAY TEST or B.A.P. BELAYER**

Extended Climbing Pass Card: 5 day card-cost \$40 (expiration: 6 months after date of purchase)

Includes equipment rental

Extended Climbing Pass Card: 10 day card-cost \$65 (expiration: 9 months after date of purchase)

Includes equipment rental

Zip Line and Giant Swing NOT included.

A.C.M. Card Holders: Harness rental \$2

A.C.M. Boulderline Tower Belay Card-cost \$15

Belayers - must hold a valid **A.C.M.** Belay Card, take a belay class or pass our belay test in order to belay on the B.A.P. climbing tower. A Hold Harmless/Medical Form must be on file.

Belayers must be at least 14 years of age. To maintain a valid belay card the holder must have belayed on the B.A.P. tower at least once in a two month period and be able to demonstrate proficiently and safely the proper belay technique.

A.C.M. Contract Belay - A.C.M. Belay Card Holders who are 16 years or older and hold a current basic first-aid and CPR card may ask to be put on our list for paid contract belay services.

A.C.M. Trip Planner Meeting – Every other month members have an informal meeting to discuss outdoor recreation opportunities and concerns. It is also an opportunity for fellowship among outdoor enthusiasts and a chance to plan private trips among members. Meetings are scheduled for 9:00am on the first Saturday of every odd numbered month at the B.A.P. picnic shelter.
